3. Initial identification	Identify a suitable date (where It is available) for the selected Tutor groups to conduct the survey between 2nd January and 29th March 2018. 4. Prior to survey being administered	Once Tutor groups have been selected, you should write to parents (by letter or email) to inform them that their child has been selected to complete the survey, giving them the opportunity to opt their child out. Suggested text has been provided. We would recommend that you send this communication from the Head Teacher of your school. Please keep a record of any opt outs received. ACTIVE LIVES letter for parents secondary	
5. Prior to survey being administered	The survey will need to be completed on a computer, laptop or tablet that has access to the internet so you may need to ensure that these facilities are booked in advance of the survey date. You should ensure that the survey domain (and all subdomains) has been whitelisted and permitted for use by pupils. This is not a web address so you cannot check it.
