

#### **SURVEY TIMINGS**

Fieldwork for the survey took place between 6th April and 27th July 2018.

#### SAMPLE

**39** pupils from **2** classes completed the survey:

18 Pupils from Year 1

21 Pupils from Year 2

**5** parents completed the survey.
